The name of the file should be the Presentation/Talk title (abbreviated, if necessary) and be sent:

- as a \*.PDF attachment,
- as a file named as the Presentation/Exhibition title (abbreviated, if necessary),
- by the deadline, Apr. 15<sup>th</sup>.
