EXHIBITION IN EUCNC 2025 & 6G SUMMIT

The 2025 European Conference on Networks and Communications & 6G Summit builds on putting together two successful conferences: EuCNC, in its 34th edition of a series, supported by the European Commission; the 6G Summit, in its 7th edition, originated from the 6G Flagship programme in Finland, one of the very first in its area. The conference is sponsored by the IEEE Communications Society (ComSoc), the European Association for Signal Processing (EURASIP) and the European Association on Antennas and Propagation (EurAAP). The conference addresses various aspects of Beyond 5G/6G communications systems and networks. It brings together cutting-edge research and world-renown industries and businesses, globally attracting in the last years close to 1 000 delegates from more than 40 countries all over the world, to present and discuss the latest results, and an exhibition with more than 50 exhibitors, for demonstrating the technology developed in the area, namely within research projects from EU programmes.

In parallel to the events, there will be a major exhibition, extending for the entire main conference days, from June 3rd to June 6th, presenting a wide range of technologies, products and results from European Commission co-funded projects. Prominent research institutions, SMEs, as well as large industries from Europe and other parts of the world will be showcasing at EuCNC & 6G Summit.

Registration:

The booth registration is complimentary, but presenters have to register to the conference. A University Demo requires the presenter to register with full (R-1-F - Full Conference Registration) or limited (R-2-L -

Limited Conference Registration) registration level. Each University Demo requires to be connected to a single registration with the limitation on one booth per person.

CALL FOR PITCHES

The conference will host Exhibitions and Demos, Universities Demos, and SMEs Demos, for the entire main conference days, in the main hall where coffee and lunch breaks will be held, where, at least during the breaks, exhibitors will have the opportunity to interact with attendees.

In order to increase the visibility of all exhibitions and demos, exhibitors are given the opportunity to apply for a Pitch at the Speakers Corner, with a targeted duration of 5 minutes, to be held during breaks, therefore, having one more means to reach the audience. The Speakers Corner will have a screen, microphone and an elevated stage, so that speakers can share their views with the audience.

Please provide your presentation as a .pptx or .PDF file, at least one week before the start of the conference to give to the organisers enough time to prepare the area and test the equipment. The presentation file should be submitted to exhibit.eucnc6gs@gmail.com.

All participants in the Speakers Corner, regardless of the nature of their presentation, must pay the registration fee and have a booth in the conference.

CONFERENCE VENUE

Located in the middle of the Poznań fairgrounds, the Poznan Congress Center is a multifunctional, three-storey building with more than 4,000 conference seats, a VIP area and a space dedicated to exhibitors and sponsor stands. The building has 38 fully-equipped conference rooms with adjustable size and a spacious foyer with an area of 2,250 square meters, ideal for exhibitions and banquets.



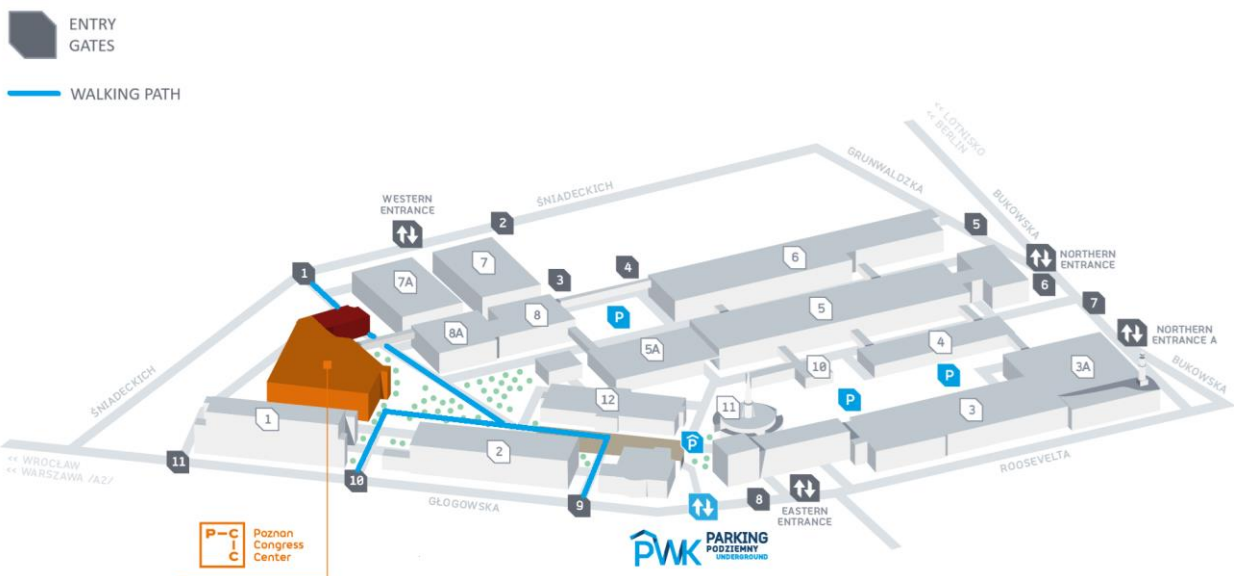

Accessibility

The Poznan Congress Center is located in the middle of the Poznań fairgrounds in the centre of the city of Poznań. It is within 2 minutes' walking distance of the Poznań Main Railway station (Poznań Główny).

Ławica Airport is located at a distance of 6 km from the fairgrounds, with the bus stop of the airport express bus located close to the northern entrance of the Poznań fairgrounds area.

The car park ([PWK](#)) Underground Parking is located at 11 Głogowska Street, on the premises of the Poznań International Fair. The entrance to the car park is located just behind the Trade Fair building, at the height of the railway station. It is open 24 hours a day and can accommodate 650 cars.

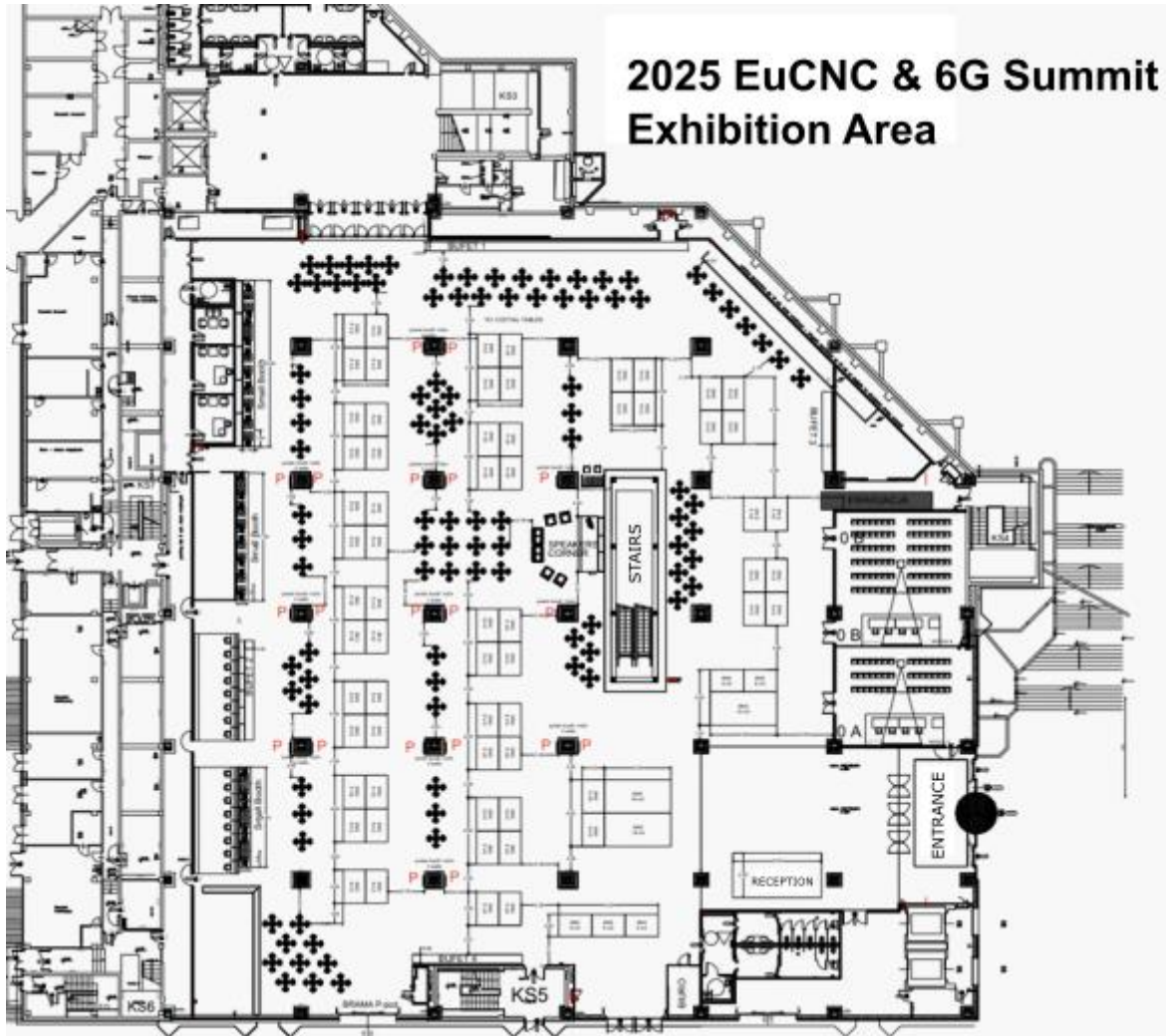

EXHIBITION

The exhibition will take place on the ground floor (Level 0) of PCC. This area will also host Coffee breaks, lunches and the Welcome Reception. The schematic below presents the possible booths layout and organisation of the exhibition.



Installation of the booths

PCC staff will coordinate the set-up and dismantling of the exhibition and are at your service throughout the conference for any questions you may have.

Booth installation is set for Monday, 2 June and Tuesday, 3 June. On Monday starting at 18.00 hrs and concluding at 21.00 hrs, on Tuesday from 08:00 hrs until 17:00 hrs. All booths must be fully prepared by 17.00 hrs. Please be advised that booth construction is prohibited during the Welcome Reception, taking place in the exhibition hall at 18.00 hrs on Tuesday.

The exact booth location for your company will be decided later and indicated on the booth of the exhibition area.

Removal of the booths

PCC staff will coordinate the dismantling of the exhibition and are at your service throughout the conference for any questions you may have.

Booths are to be removed on Friday, June 6, immediately after 11.00 hrs until 15.00 hrs.

Booths may on no account be removed earlier or on another date. We urge you to respect the congress time schedule and to await the end of the congress to remove your booth.

IMPORTANT: Exhibitors must not leave any waste behind. All associated costs will be charged.

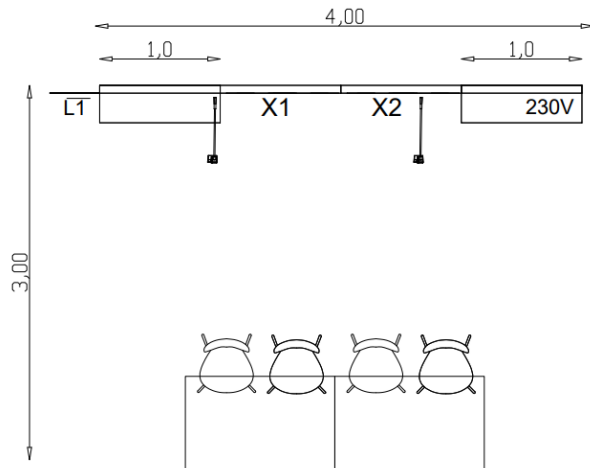

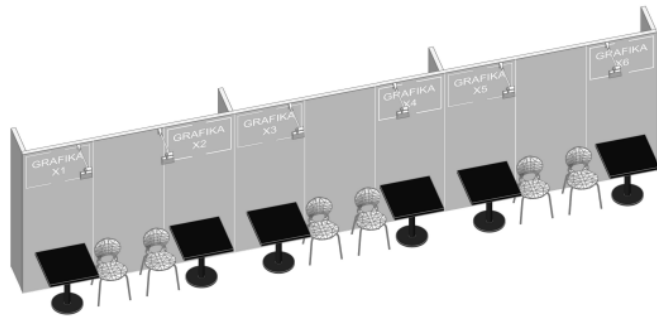

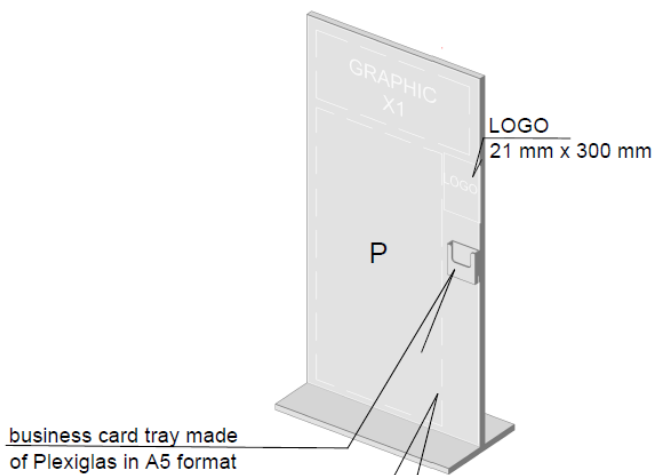

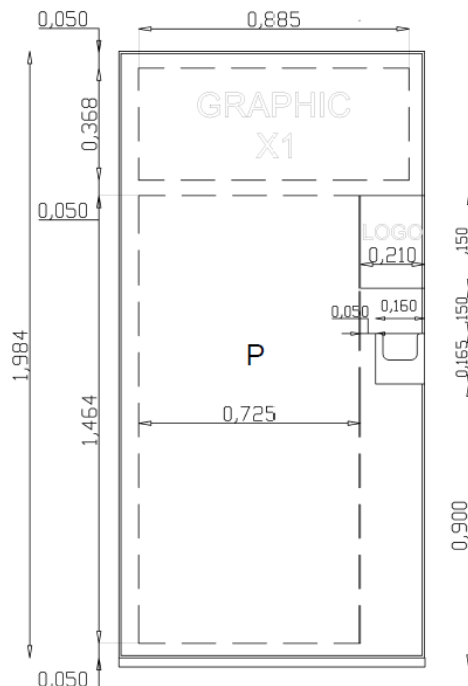
